

COUNCIL 10136 MEETING MINUTES 06-09-2025

Meeting called to order at 7:35 pm by the Grand Knight.

Membership cards were not checked by Warden, however, all present were identified as members in good standing.

Prayer was offered by the Grand Knight.

After the Pledge of Allegiance, roll was waived. Previous meeting minutes were approved.

The Treasurer report was read into the record by the Treasurer. The beginning balance was \$85,698.19. Credits were \$1,671.42 and disbursements were \$1,277.84 for a checking balance of \$86,091.77. The Fr. John Fund totals \$60,455.32 for a total balance of \$146,547.09. Outstanding checks total \$1,074.89. The Tapped and Uncorked balance is \$100.00. We owe Fr. John Fund \$2,471.36.

The Chaplain reminded us of the feast of Corpus Christi coming up on Sunday June 22 with the procession beginning after the 12 noon Mass. There will be a parade on the parish parking lot with three stops. We will provide the Honor Guard that will accompany the canopy. We will also host a social afterwards.

The Recorder stated we received a letter from the Serra Club thanking us for our donation to the Serra Golf Tournament for their vocation efforts.

The Financial Secretary said 11 members had not paid their dues but 5 eventually did with the help of the trustee follow up and 6 members are being removed from our roster and placed in the affiliate program. The names of those members have been sent to our District Deputy, Steve McMullin.

Relating to the Budget: The following items were removed: We are no longer doing the 50/50 drawing. The 4th degree Hospitality has been removed, the scholarship program has been removed, the cub scouts and the Valentine's dance have also been removed. There are no magnet sales anymore. The budget was approved as amended.

The Grand Knight reported we can spend up to \$250 for food for our meetings and members can sign up online to volunteer to get the food for the meetings. All you have to do is pay for and pick up the food and present the receipt to the financial secretary for reimbursement at the meeting.
