

COUNCIL 10136 MEETING MINUTES 09-08-2025

Meeting called to order at 7:35 pm by the Grand Knight.

Membership cards were not checked by Warden, however, all present were identified as members in good standing.

Prayer was offered by the Grand Knight.

After Pledge of Allegiance, roll was waived. Previous meeting minutes were approved.

The Treasurer report was read into the record by the Treasurer. The beginning balance was \$71,568.76. Credits were \$10,003.37 disbursements were \$11,360.83 for a checking balance of \$70,211.30. The Fr. John Fund totals \$55,334.27 for a total balance of \$125,545.57. Outstanding checks total \$4,171.61. The Tapped and Uncorked balance is \$2,271.01, amount owed to Fr. John Fund is \$6,471.36.

Chaplain Fr. D'Amico stated the last Saturday Mass of September (September 27) is scheduled as the Mass in the Grass at 5PM. Mass will also be said in the church. After Mass food will be sold for cost and there will be karaoke.

Trustee Eric Treptow stated he will give a report on the upcoming fish fry when we get closer to the fish fry. The council storage cage needs work, moving shelves and cleanup in addition to adding led lights. Eric also mentioned that he and Sheila will be having their bonfire on November 2 starting at 3 PM. Construction on the cell tower on the parish property has begun.

Trustee Matt Moore stated that you can order new KofC shirts at a price of \$24 for short sleeve and \$28 for long sleeve with an additional \$2 charge for larger sizes.

The Recorder gave a report on correspondence to the council: We received the Defenders of the Unborn July Newsletter that gave reports of their prolife activities. The council received thank you notes from 6 seminarians that the council sponsors. We received an invitation from Our Lady of Guadalupe for Life organization to attend Mass on October 12 at Orlando's at 4300 Hoffmeister Ave. At 4:00P M, keynote speaker is Fr. Edward Hopkins, LC, cost is \$100.00 per person, RSVP by September 22. Walk For The Poor at Queen of All Saints is scheduled for September 28, 2024 at 1 PM. The walk is at 1 PM followed by the Celebration of Charity lunch. Shirts for the walk will be sold after Mass on the 14th and 21st of September. Keep Christ in Christmas order form was received that can be used for ordering Keep Christ in Christmas items such as magnets, Christmas cards, ornaments, Christmas seals and yard signs.

Chancellor Mike Amad thanked all the volunteers that helped on Sunday, August 31st. The next Knights s sponsored Mass is scheduled for November 30th, more volunteers are still needed. Any Knights attending are encouraged to wear your blue Knights' shirt and your name badge. The men's White House retreat is scheduled for September 18-21.
