

## COUNCIL 10136 MEETING MINUTES 3-9-2026

Meeting called to order at 7:35 pm by the Grand Knight.

Membership cards were not checked by Warden, however, all present were identified as members in good standing.

Previous meeting minutes were approved.

The Treasurer report was read into the record by the Grand Knight. The beginning balance was \$47,575.91. Credits were \$44,752.28 disbursements were \$18,105.93 for a checking balance of \$74,222.26. The Fr. John Fund totals \$58,403.59 for a total balance of \$132,625.85. Outstanding checks total \$18,173.20. The Tapped and Uncorked balance is \$100.00, amount owed to Fr. John Fund is \$1,671.36. The Grand Knight also reported that Tony Jaskiewicz made and brought the food for this month's meeting. The next Men's Acts Retreat is scheduled for April 9 through 12. The Grand Knight also reported for the Financial Secretary that there are 24 members that are delinquent for their membership dues including 6 that are 2 or more years delinquent. The Queen of Hearts jackpot is near \$100,000.00. The River City Casino fund raiser is March 28, buy tickets to help with the fundraiser. The new March Madness Pool runs from March 17 to April 8, cost per bracket is \$10, 50% of winnings go to the parish with the other 50% to the winner.

The Recorder reported a flyer from The Society of St. Vincent De Paul thanking us for our contributions, a thank you note from Serra Club of St. Louis for vocation programs in the Archdiocese of St. Louis for our donation valued at \$2,000.00, and a thank you note from Nurses for Newborns for our donation of \$1,000.00.

Trustee Eric Treptow reported we are doing great for the number of meals sold and the money raised from the Fish Fry. The last big order of food for the Fish Fry will be ordered soon and help is needed at the next Fish Fry to fry the fish, carry out lines and clean up help.

Mike Kurkowski reported that an additional donation of \$1,500.00 to the Gilded Knight Gala at the River City Casino would be used to help the safety and security of the school and parish. Fr. Murphy suggested that security cameras could be installed that could be monitored by the police for security. Mike Kurkowski proposed the additional \$1,500.00 donation which was voted on and approved unanimously.

Dave Beckerle thanked all the volunteers who have helped with the basketball tournament.

Insurance Agent Tim Buback stated that on May 21, 2026 at the Arnold Council (Pope John XXIII) would be having the next District meeting.
