

COUNCIL 10136 MEETING MINUTES 4-13-2026

Meeting called to order at 7:35 pm by the Grand Knight.

Outstanding checks total \$9,466.54. The Tapped and Uncorked balance is \$100.00, amount owed to Fr. John Fund is \$1,671.36.
