

## COUNCIL 10136 MEETING MINUTES 5-11-2026

Meeting called to order at 7:35 pm by the Grand Knight.

Membership cards were not checked by Warden, however, all present were identified as members in good standing.

Previous meeting minutes were approved.

The Treasurer report was read into the record by the Grand Knight. The beginning balance was \$115,530.74. Credits were \$468.52 disbursements were \$4,761.60 for a checking balance of \$111,237.76. The Fr. John Fund totals \$60,776.69 for a total balance of \$172,014.45. Outstanding checks total \$3,285.86. The Tapped and Uncorked balance is \$100.00, amount owed to Fr. John Fund is \$1,671.36.

Eric Treptow reported that the new roof for the school will be done after school is out. New ceiling tiles will be put up inside the school starting early in the summer. The dehumidifier in the cafeteria is out of commission and will be disassembled to access the copper inside to be recycled. The cafeteria door will also be replaced after school is out and will be installed by Keith Hanson keeping the cost of the replacement under budget.

Mike Kurkowski reported that Tapped and Uncorked is scheduled for October 3. The next meeting for the event will be on May 19. Cards to advertise the event will be available later.

Chancellor Mike Amad stated that the last Sunday of the month of May is the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month. Another hospitality minister is needed and 5 extraordinary ministers are needed. The next White House retreat scheduled for September 17-20 has signed up 59 retreatants, 24 of which are from the Council. There are still 31 slots open for the retreat. Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly has sent out an email asking for Knights to pray a Novena from June 3-11 for the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the United States.

Steve Sallwasser gave a presentation on Mo Scholarships which would aid Catholic Education. In order to participate go to the Mo Scholars tab on the State of Missouri Treasurer's website to make a pledge. 12 families at QAS have benefitted from this program.

Matt Moore has 5 KofC hats for sale at \$22 each. 4 shirt orders are pending.

The Grand Knight reported that Eric Treptow prepared the food for this month's meeting. We need someone to step up to take care of the food for the June meeting. This Sunday is Donut Sunday to be hosted by the Council, volunteers are still needed. The Men's Ministries meet at St. Joseph on Thursdays and at St. Francis of Assisi on Saturdays. The next Women's Acts Retreat is scheduled for September 24 through 27. The Queen of Hearts jackpot is near \$135,000.00. The Parish Picnic is scheduled for June 12 and 13. The Knights will be working the Chuck-A-Luck booth under the leadership of Scott Gurly. With the addition of 12 new members the Council qualifies for Star Council. Council elections will be held next month in June. A new Recording Secretary, Trustee and Deputy Grand Knight are needed as those positions will be vacant.
